

PRE-PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CATHETERIZATION/STENT

- NPO: Please do not eat or drink anything other than water after midnight (or at least 8 full hours)
- If on Blood thinners (such as-warfarin, Xarelto, Eliquis, Pradaxa): Hold for 3 days before procedure, unless instructed differently by your doctor.
- If on Aspirin or Plavix or Effient or Brilinta- no need to hold.
- **Diuretics:** (Furosemide (Lasix), Hydrochlorothiazide (HCTZ), Torsemide (Demadex), Spironolactone (Aldactone), hold the morning of the procedure
- Insulin: ½ dose insulin the night prior to the procedure, no insulin morning of the procedure.
- **Diabetic Medications**: Please hold your diabetic medication the night prior or morning of the procedure.
- Length of Stay: You will probably be in the hospital for 5-6 hours. You may even need to spend the night at the hospital (if stent is needed) and might want to consider packing an overnight bag.
- You will need a ride home.
